VDA Park Equipment Meets Safety Standards: Quality Assurance Tests Conducted on Park Equipment by QCI

VDA Takes Firm Action Against Illegal Construction in Varanasi

Sealing Action: Enforcement Crackdown on Illegal Construction in Varanasi

Following directives from the Vice Chairman, the Varanasi Development Authority's enforcement team in Zone 3 took decisive action against illegal construction. Notices were issued under sections 27, 28(i), and 28(ii) of the Uttar Pradesh Town Planning and Development Act, 1973. The target was unauthorised construction by Ajay Kumar in front of buildings K-62/44 and 62/54 in Saptasagar Dawa Mandi, Ward-Kotwali. The construction was sealed on May 7, 2024, and the site was handed over to Kotwali police station for ongoing monitoring. Zonal Officer Singh Saurabh Dev Prajapati and Assistant Engineer Ravindra Prakash supervised the operation, ensuring strict compliance with urban regulations.

VDA Enforces Regulations, Seals Illegal Construction

Varanasi Development Authority Takes Action Against Illegal Construction in Zone-4

Following directives from the Vice Chairman, the enforcement team of Varanasi Development Authority in Zone-4 conducted sealing actions against illegal construction. In Ward-Nagwan, Gayatri Devi, near Mauja Kandwapal Basti, was found to be constructing a 30 × 60 feet ground floor building without approved plans. On May 10, 2024, under sections 27, 28 (I), and 28 (ii) of the Uttar Pradesh Town Planning and Development Act, 1973, the construction was officially sealed and placed under the oversight of the Manduadih police station. Zonal Officer Pramod Tiwari and Assistant Engineer RK Singh were present to oversee the
